- Practice recording or taking pictures
- Zooming, sound control, light.
- Power on/off, Rewind, fast forward.

**III. Gather needed material**

- Video tape everything needed
- Internet research for video clip/pictures

**IV. Importing video & pictures**

- Using Play, Rewind, and Fast Forward buttons, position the tape to just before the footage you want.
- Importing movie, knowing your timecodes
- Using Timeline

**V. Working with Clips**

- Renaming clips if needed
- Edit, trimming or removing clips
- Splitting clips
- Cropping clips
- Creating still clip
- Restoring a clip

**VI. Adding Transition**

- Setting up and applying a transition
- Modifying and deleting transitions

**VII. Using Special Effects**

- Brightness and contrast adjustments
- Color Adjustments (Hue Shift, Color, Lightness)
- Special Effects

**VIII. Adding Text (title)**

- Exploring iMovie's Title types
- Adding and removing main titles
- Using Timeline viewer for transition, effects, and titles
- Adding credits

## **IX. Sound**

- Extracting audio
- Removing, copying, cutting, and pasting audio
- Moving audio clips
- Splitting and cropping audio clips
- Adding sound effects and music
- Adding narration
- Adding background music (getting music from CD)

- Exporting to Quicktime
- Exporting for iDVD
- Make DVD
