### Optional Fishing Trips for Early 2009

Dear Parents:

Thank you for enrolling your child in the Nimitz Enrichment Fishing class. To provide the students enrolled an actual chance to fish, we will be hosting 2 field trips on Saturday morning to the Santa Cruz Wharf. Attendance at these field trips is *OPTIONAL*. However, in previous classes, this was **a lot of fun for both kids and parents**.

Tentatively, our plans are to go fishing on:

**Saturday, November 7, 2009 – 7:15am – 9:30am**

**Saturday, November 14, 2009 – 7:15am – 9:30am**

**Location:** Santa Cruz Wharf. From Sunnyvale, take Hwy 85 South, to Hwy 17 to Santa Cruz. Travel about 30 minutes then take Highway 1 north exit, turn left on River Street (Highway 9), right on North Pacific Avenue, right on Mission Street, left on Cedar Street, right on Laurel Street, left on Center Street, which turns into South Pacific Avenue, to Beach Street, to enter the wharf.

**Parking** is right on the wharf! Yes, drive all the way back as far as there is roadway on the wharf, and we will be fishing on the right hand side. Parking is **FREE** in the early mornings if we depart before 10am.

**Fishing Licenses are NOT required** of any children under 16 of age. Fishing licenses are also NOT required of anglers fishing from any California Saltwater Public Pier. This means Parents can fish too! We will provide extra rods and reels and all the required tackle for the kids and adults. Feel free to bring other children. We will also have refreshments with us for the kids.
