Galit Lev-Ran called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m. This week's agenda, last meetings minutes and an email from Fiona about the current budget were distributed.

1. Accept Minutes

- Susannah made a motion that the minutes from the March 19th meeting be accepted. Galit seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

2. Principal's report (Dale)

- Bathrooms –
 1. Student bathrooms will get an extra daily check.
 2. The district did a spot inspection on the cleanliness of the Nimitz bathrooms and found them to be satisfactory.
 3. The sinks have been power washed
 4. Dale will talk to the Student Council about encouraging the students to help maintain clean bathrooms.

James and Dora will be arranging a Barbecue dinner that will start at 5:30. There will be a web reply/response system and volunteer sign up. Because this event is around the time of the school's 50th anniversary, we will have gold colored decorations and try to play a few 50's songs.

3. President's Report (Galit)

- Wall Mural (Tracy) - \$600 have been contributed by families for the personalize tile in the Mural. More flyers will be sent out. The mural will be put up May 18th through the 25th.
- Celebration of Cultural Arts – The Diversity Committee has arranged for 13 different cultures to perform during a 1.5 hour show to be held June 1st (12:30 – 3:00) following a common school lunch. Plans are being made to have the performances video recorded and made available on DVD for the performers. There is also a plan to have upper grade students make posters with trivia about different cultures/countries. Students who find answers to a questionnaire will be able to get a small goody.

4. Committee Reports

- Book Fair - \$10,055.36 was taken in. There are some expenses (ie. food for volunteers). We can get \$5573.41 of vouchers towards Scholastic books or \$2786.71 cash. It has been decided to take the ~\$2500 in cash. A post-mortem on the book fair will be planned to discuss this year's book fair and possible future book fairs.
- Budget (Susannah) – went over the contents of Fiona's email on the status of the budget.
- Spiritwear sales – \$1433.00 was taken in. The tie-dye shirts were very popular.
- Music for Minors – Cathy Lampman says they would like to get a Nimitz parent to volunteer to be a music docent for K-3 classes. This requires a commitment to take 2 classes in Mid-September to November. James will try to promote/recruit on the PTA website.

- Kindergarten playgroup (Tracy) – needs a volunteer(s) to assist the coordinator of the Kindergarten playgroup it over the summer and next year. Dora has recruited Renu Pontil to act as the principal coordinator of the playgroup next year.
- Ms. Woods iMovie project prize proposal – Galit made a motion to purchase 45 movie tickets. The motion was seconded by Tracy. Motion was voted on and approved.
- Volunteer Tea – is being arranged by Maria Bennett and Jeannette Yama this year.
